August 30, 1937 - August 21, 2011

BELCHERTOWN-Barbara T. Stueckroth, 73, died August 21, 2011 at home. Born on August 30, 1937 in Springfield, MA to the late Ernest and Evelyn (Gaus) Setterstrom, she had worked for many years for the Wall Street Journal. Barbara was a member and former Vice-Chairman of the Loyal Order of Moose, Lodge 1489, the American Union of Swedish Singers, Rhode Island Chapter, VASA Order of America where she served as Chaplain, Vice Chairman of the Lodge, Recording Secretary of the Lodge and the Outer Guard of the Lodge.
