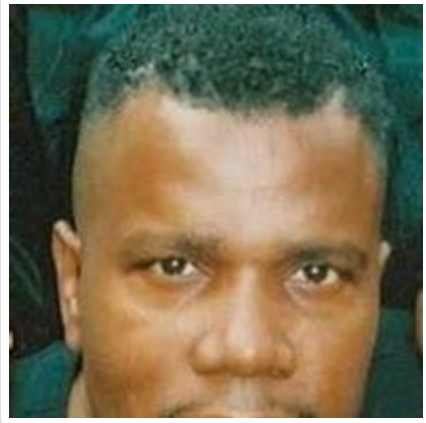




Coley Brown III
