LUDLOW-Gordon L. "Bud" Maynard, 89, died May 25, 2012 at the Soldier's Home in Holyoke, MA. Born in the Brightwood section of Springfield, MA on October 7, 1922 to the late Claude and Shirley (Goodrich) Maynard, he was a longtime resident of Ludlow and he and his wife were Daytona, FL residents for 14 years. He had been employed as a gunsmith at Savage Arms for over 30 years. A proud veteran of the US Navy he served during WW II and received 14 battle stars and 2 presidential citations.
