Minister James W. Harmon, 41, passed away on November 3, 2020. Born in Brooklyn, NY on November 23, 1978 to Orlando and Charlene (Bradley) Harmon, he was a graduate of Roger L. Putnam Vocational Technical High School and had worked in various positions at Chez Josef, the Sheraton, the Postal Service and as a bus monitor for Springfield Public Schools. The most important thing to James was his ministry at Universal Spiritual Outreach Center which included 21 years preaching at Hampden County House of Correction, visiting hospitals and nursing homes.
