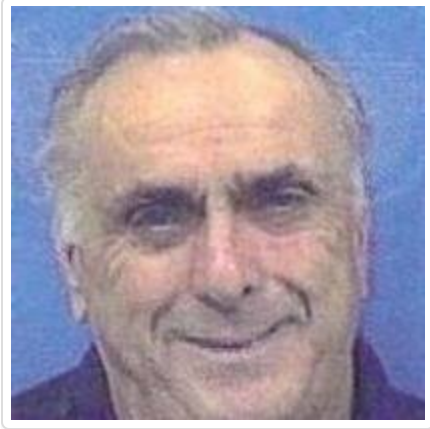




John V. Fiorentino
