After the death of her sister, Lucille went on the road to peoples homes to do hair for people who couldn’t get out. She also volunteered for Hospice Life Care for 6 years. She leaves to cherish her memories her loving daughter and best friend Dianne Lemay and her fiancé David Laliberte. She always said of David, “If I had a son I would want him to be like you.” She also leaves many nephews, especially Richard Dent who was so kind to her and many nieces; her best friend Millie Reid and her daughter Cathleen.
