There will be no services at this time. A Memorial Picnic or two, will be planned for some time in June 2024. An announcement will be made at that time.

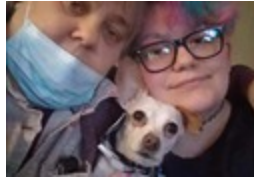
