Springfield – Norman F. LaGasse, 92, husband of the late Lorraine “Ronnie” (Moore) LaGasse, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, March 14, 2017 in a local nursing home.

He was born in Springfield on May 9, 1924, a son of the late Wilfred and Antoinette (Boutin) LaGasse and attended local schools.

He served in the US Army during WWII and was a disabled veteran, receiving the Purple Heart. After serving his country, he was employed as a dental equipment salesman by GCAmerica for many years.
