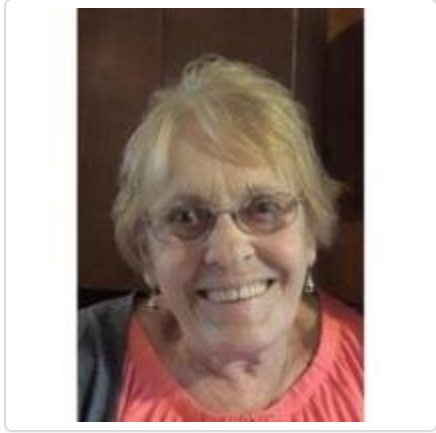




Patricia R. Chilson
